Just because I can't help you doesn't mean you don't have a case

Just because I choose not to accept your case, doesn't mean you don't have a valid case. You want to know why? Come join me for a moment as I share with you some great information.

Hi, I'm Gerry Oginski of the New York Medical Malpractice, and [inaudible 00:00:15] attorney practicing law in the state of New York.

There are many times when someone will get on the phone with me, and I will tell them politely, "I'm sorry, I can't handle your case." Many times, these people who are calling, firmly believe that they have a valid case. They think that simply because I won't take them on as a client, it means that they don't have a case. The reality is just the opposite. The mere fact that one attorney chooses not to take on someone as a client, doesn't necessarily mean you don't have a valid basis for a case. There are many factors that will go into deciding and evaluating whether or not an attorney will take on your case.

You should know this. Not every case is right for every attorney. There are attorneys who handle specific types of cases, and there are attorneys who have experience with specific cases. The type of case that you have, the specifics, may not be ideal for the attorney that you are calling. Just because an attorney turns down your case and will not accept you as a client, does not in any way, mean that you don't have a valid basis for a case.

The only way to know for sure is to find an attorney who is willing to look into and investigate your matter. You do a thorough investigation, have experts review the records, and then come to a conclusion about whether or not there's wrongdoing, there's liability, there's

causation, and there's damages. For a medical malpractice case specifically, we are absolutely required to have a medical expert confirm that you have a valid basis for a case before we are permitted to proceed forward.
