If they're wearing a dark suit, that's typically the attire that an attorney will wear -- dark suit, crisp white shirt, and power red tie. Obviously there are variations and people don't always wear this, but the majority of trial attorneys who go into court and try cases on a regular basis that is what you will see them wearing over and over again. And it's designed to give the jury the impression that we mean business, that we know what we're doing, and we are an authority in what we are doing. And that's all it's designed to do, otherwise you'd see attorneys wearing multicolored shirts, wearing multicolored ties, as well as multicolored suits. And you know what? That does happen from time to time. That's not to say that trial attorneys only wear dark-colored suits. But the majority of them do. And especially this is true during jury selection. So, if you ever happen to go in for jury selection, for jury duty and now you get put into a room with 25 other people, and now you meet your attorneys for the very first time, take a look quickly at what the attorneys are wearing. Don't give it a second thought, just take a glance. The attorney who is wearing the dark blue suit with the power tie, with a crisp white shirt, will in all likelihood be the attorney who represents the injured victim in an accident case or a medical malpractice case or in a wrongful death case. That's simply what the attorneys wear. So, why do I share this great information with you? I share it with you just to give you an insight and an understanding into what goes on in these types of cases here in New York.
